## CEYX still jamming after 30 years

Thirty years ago three local high school students formed a band that is still going strong today.

"Our show is something for everybody," CEYX band member Dean Rusch said of the band's longevity.

Back in 1971 Swan Valley High School student Bob Strunk, Rusch of Hemlock High School and Tom Miller of Midland came together as CEYX, pronounced "cease."

Rusch, of Thomas Township, plays the drums; Strunk, now of Kalamazoo, plays guitar and keyboards; and Miller, of Midland, plays keyboards, guitar and the saxophone.

The band plays all types of events such as fund-raisers, weddings, proms, reunions, conventions, fairs and festivals. They have performed over 2,000 events since 1971.

Rusch attributes the band's success to their wide variety of music. CEYX plays everything from oldies to rock and roll, modern music to Top 40, and even ventures into country music.

"We play music for 8 year olds to 80 year olds," he said. "We play recognizable music."

Rusch said the band is still per-

forming crowd favorites, but has included new songs this year. The band also takes requests during concerts.

"We'll do a couple songs no one has heard us play before," Rusch said.
